

Holy Spirit window sticker

You will need: Scissors White paper or card Cotton wool
Crayons/felts Glue stick Blotak

If you have them (but you can make this with just the things above):
Coloured paper, coloured tissue or coloured cellophane Clear, stiff plastic



How to make your Holy Spirit sticker:

1. Cut out the dove, the flames and the wind (if you are going to use that)
2. Cover the dove with thin cotton wool to look like feathers and glue it into place.
3. Colour the flames red /yellow/orange to look like fire. You could cut them out of tissue or cellophane instead if you have it.
4. Arrange the flames behind the dove and glue them in place.
5. If you have some stiff clear plastic, glue the dove with the flames on to the plastic.
6. Using a little blotak around the back of the dove and flames, gently press it onto your window to let the light shine through. This works especially well if you have been able to use tissue or cellophane for the flames. You can stick the 'wind' onto the window too if you wish.
