### **Bible Discussion Group**


Thursday Bible Discussion – Grow in Faith, Share in Fellowship


# **Morning Prayer**

We will be doing the 'Practicing the Way' course, a resource designed to help each of us with our spiritual formation in the modern world, giving teaching and tips to put spiritual practices into place in our ordinary lives.

It works best if people attend each session to build on the material of the last, but it is fine to attend as availability allows!
